

Full Privacy Statement

The Female Falconers Club treats the security of member information very seriously and we take appropriate measures to safeguard your privacy. This policy explains how we protect and manage any personal data you share with us and that we hold about you.

Personal data means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including name, company name, home and email address or other contact information. We may also collect and process records of any correspondence and communications with us.

We will only disclose your personal information in connection with membership or associated services (eg liability insurance) to the extent required or permitted by law.

How do we look after personal data?

We only collect personal data that is required for the purposes of providing, administering and managing membership to the Female Falconers Club. We also collect payment transaction information such as the date and time payment was made. We do not store any card data. We may use your personal data to provide information on Club events, news and information and Club offers.

We restrict, secure and control all of the data we hold, against unauthorised access, damage, loss or destruction; whether physical or electronic. We retain personal data only for as long as is necessary to perform the functions above and to respond to your requests, or longer if required by law. If we retain your personal data for historical or statistical purposes we will ensure that the personal data cannot be used for any other purpose. Whilst in our possession, together with your assistance, we try to maintain the accuracy of your personal data.

Information provided by you

At various points (eg event bookings), we may need to collect information about you or your family/fellow guests via email, online application or over the telephone, as well as on an enquiry form. We expect you to ensure that they know you are doing so and they are content with their information being provided to us.

Children's Privacy

Because we care about the safety and privacy of children online, we comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 (COPPA). COPPA and its accompanying regulations protect the privacy of children using the internet. We do not knowingly contact or collect personal information from children under the age of 13. The website is not intended to solicit information of any kind from children under the age of 13.

How long do we keep this information about you?

We keep information in line with the retention policy of the Female Falconers Club. These retention periods are in line with the length of time we need to keep your personal information in order to

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manage and administer your membership. They also take into account our need to meet any legal, statutory and regulatory obligations. These reasons can vary from one piece of information to the next. In all cases our need to use your personal information will be reassessed on a regular basis and information which is no longer required will destroyed/deleted.

Social Media

We adopt a safe and responsible Social Media Policy. Should you choose to sign in or interact with using any of our social media platforms, we will collect personal data relevant to that platform for example your username, handle or your profile picture and any information that you have chosen to make public on our social media accounts. Facebook, for example, often collects personal data including name, age and location.

How can you access your personal data?

You have the right to request access to any of your personal data we may hold. If any of that information is incorrect, you can request that we change it. If we are not using your information correctly, you can request that we stop using it or that we delete it completely.

Where we have asked for your consent to use your personal data, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you withdraw your consent, we will stop using your personal data where legally possible. Any processing undertaken before your withdrawal remains valid and lawful.

If you would like to make a request to see what personal data of yours we hold, you may make a request to the President of the Club.

We shall respond promptly from the point of receiving the request and all necessary information from you. Our formal response shall include details of the personal data we hold about you, including the following:

- Sources from which we acquired the information,
- The purposes for processing the information, and
- Persons or entities with whom we are sharing the information.
